BILLIONAIRES FOR WEALTHCARE PROTEST ANTI-BILLIONAIRE AGENDA OF MICHAEL MOORE

"PROFITS ALWAYS COME BEFORE PEOPLE," GROUP SAYS.

Billionaires for Wealthcare, the satirical street theater group composed of "Health Insurance CEOs, HMO lobbyists, and others profiting from our broken health care system," protested today at the DC premiere of Michael Moore's new film, "Capitalism: A Love Story."
